COFFEYVILLE REFINERY CELEBRATES 100 YEARS IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY

Coffeyville, Kan. (Aug. 18, 2006) — Coffeyville Resources, LLC announced today that it has installed historical photo displays at the Montgomery County Courthouse and at Coffeyville City Hall to mark the centennial anniversary of its refinery operations in Southeastern Kansas.

The display chronicles the growth of the Coffeyville refinery from its founding by The National Refining Company as a 2,500 barrel per day refinery in August 1906 to today's highly complex 100,000 BPD facility and associated nitrogen fertilizer plant.

Coffeyville Resources, established in March 2004, announced plans earlier this year to expand crude oil throughput to 115,000 bpd and increase nitrogen fertilizer production to approximately 1 million tons per year.

“We know that our growth and success is tied closely to the hard work and dedication of our employees, and the support of our community,” said Jack Lipinski, Coffeyville Resources chief executive officer. “On behalf of Coffeyville Resources, I want to express our sincere gratitude to the citizens and leadership of Coffeyville and Montgomery County who have supported the refinery and its associated operations for the past 100 years.”
